**Base Pricing Formula=** ((Average Wholesale Price - Acquisition Cost) \* (1-Sliding Fee Discount %))+Acquisition Cost)

**Cap price:**the maximum price paid for a prescription unless the acquisition cost exceeds that amount

**Dispensing fee:** the nominal amount added to the acquisition cost of the medication in the event cap price exceeds acquisition cost
